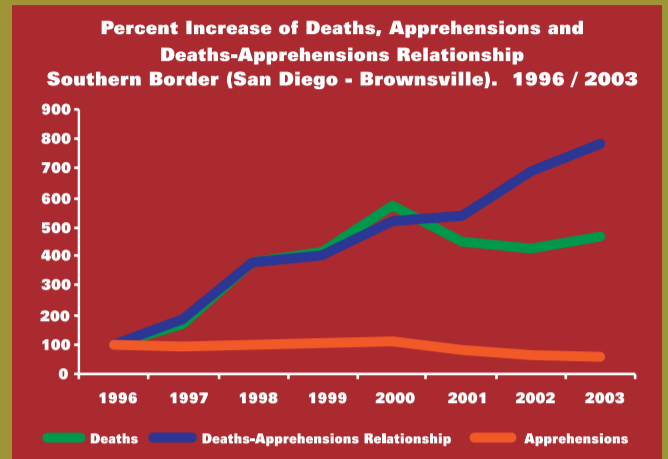
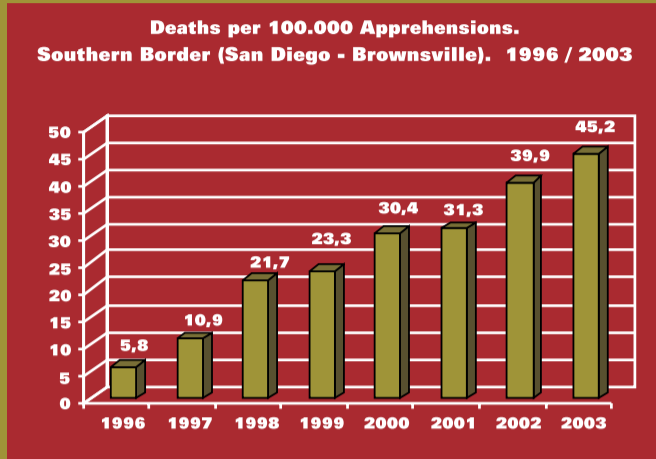


# Risks in the southern border of the United States: Analysis from the perspective of migrants

## OBJECTIVE

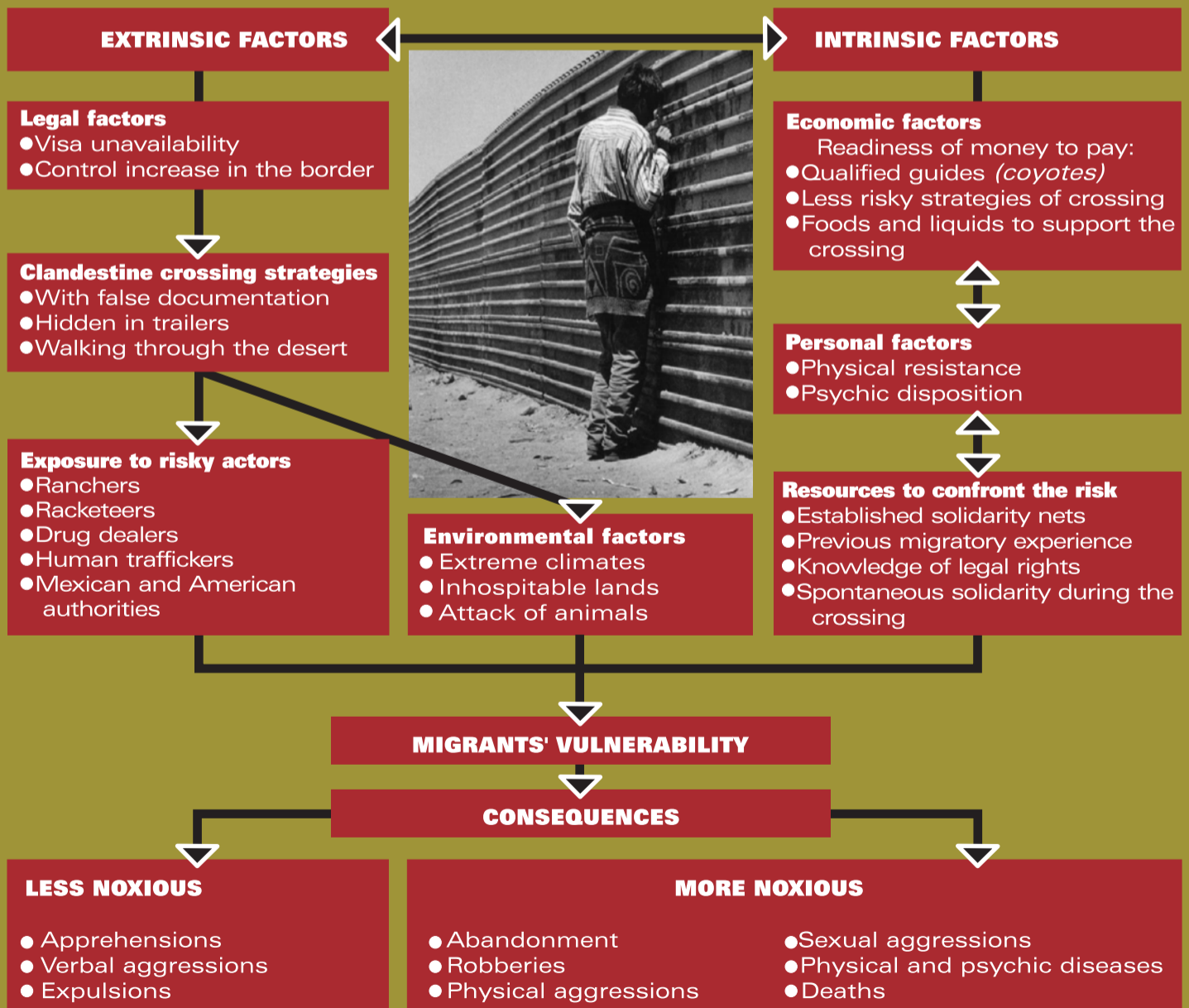
To establish a migratory risk scheme of the undocumented crossings of the US southern border

## METHODOLOGY

Qualitative analysis of Mexican migrants' testimonies. The interviews were carried out in Chicago City (Illinois, USA) and Veracruz State (Mexico)

## FINDINGS

The magnitude of risk depends on the combination of migrants' extrinsic and intrinsic factors



## POLICY IMPLICATION

- To enact an integral migratory policy that assigns priority to humanitarian treatment, the respect to the rights of migrants, and the eradication of abuses
- To give special attention toward the most vulnerable groups: children, women and older people
